**ANNEX B – SELF SUSTAINMENT**

**Guidelines for submission of cost data**

This Annex of the national cost data package is for Member States to submit cost information on self-sustainment items listed in the Contingent-Owned Equipment (COE) Manual (A/72/288). The sheet in **tab 2** of this Annex requests information on the following categories as listed in Chapter 8, Annex B of the Manual:

- Catering
- Communications
- Office
- Electrical
- Minor Engineering
- Explosive Ordnance Disposal
- Laundry
- Cleaning
- Tentage
- Accommodation
- Basic firefighting
- Fire detection and alarm
- Medical
- Observation
- Identification

- Nuclear, biological and chemical protection
- Field defence stores
- Miscellaneous general stores
- Internet access
- Unique equipment

The sheet in **tab 2** (National Cost Data for SS) lists the categories/sub-categories for which Member States are requested to provide the national costs of providing self-sustainment. These costs should be based on a generic infantry battalion of 700 personnel operating from three locations, expressed on a per person/per month basis.

**In Column (d) of tab 2, please list the national cost per person per month for each self-sustainment category and sub-category. Items deployed to meet a higher national standard are considered a national responsibility and are not to be included.**

Member States should take advantage of their previous experiences in United Nations peacekeeping missions, where applicable, to provide data based on actual costs incurred. To assist the Secretariat in the consolidation of the spreadsheets, it would be appreciated if all national costs could be provided in **US dollars**.

To ensure consistency and comparability of data submitted from Member States, see the “Catering Sample”, in tab 3 of this Annex, which contains the standard methodology template to follow in calculating national costs. This template contains sample data for illustration purpose only, using the example of the self-sustainment category “Catering”.

**Tab 4** of this Annex named “Minor Equipment Sample ” contains a list of equipment associated with each self-sustainment category. It is important to include in the determination of the national costs only those items required to meet the performance standards self-sustainment approved by the General Assembly as reflected in Chapter 3, Annex B of the COE Manual (A/72/288). Items deployed to meet a higher national standard are considered a national responsibility and are not to be included.

*Please also refer to Chapter 3, annex B of the COE Manual (A/72/288) on performance standards for minor equipment and consumables provided under self sustainment .*

*It is requested that Member States do not leave any field blank and indicate either the national cost for the equipment or if the equipment is not available in the national inventory, to mark not available/N/A.*
