



# PROVIDE DATA ON MINOR LOSS AND DAMAGE (LESS THAN 10% OF GFMV) TO COE DURING TRANSIT & REVIEW OF THRESHOLD CEILING FOR LOSS AND DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT

Secretariat Issue Paper #14 and Issue Paper #15 – Mandated Studies

Issue Paper Theme: **Major Equipment**

## BACKGROUND

The Secretariat was mandated by the 2020 COE Working Group to:

1. Collect data from troop and police contributing countries on the loss or damage of the equipment, as and when it happens, and to compile the annual record to support the review of the threshold ceiling in the 2023 COE Working Group.
2. Provide data on loss or damage during transit less than 10 per cent of the Generic Fair Market Value (GFMV) and the Secretariat to provide data on claims for loss or damage during transit for 10 per cent or more of GFMV submitted by the troop/police contributors and present it to the 2023 COE Working Group.

## PROPOSAL

The Secretariat retrieved the following data from the UCM (Uniformed Capabilities Management) system:
