SUMMARY OF PROPOSAL

Hospitals in mission area are multispecialty health care providing facilities comprising of various departments and areas of patient care such as Accident & Emergency, Specialist OPD Complex, Pathology & Laboratory services, Radiology services, Intensive care Unit, Operation theatre complex, Patient wards, Pharmacy, ancillary services etc. Hospitals are required to deploy medical and dental facilities as per standards defined in Chapter 3, annex C of COE Manual 2020. However, all medical and dental facilities provided by the hospital have been considered as a single Medical and Dental equipment for the purpose of reimbursements. Deficiency/temporary non-serviceability of any one medical/dental equipment renders the complete medical module of the hospital unserviceable resulting in substantial loss of reimbursements. It is proposed that the reimbursements for hospitals should be equipment/ department specific wherein each equipment or department is treated as a separate module with separate reimbursement rates.
